

## 48,277 CSCs completed/in progress under GKRA



As many as 48,277 Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) are nearing completion under Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyaan (GKRA), a 125-day campaign launched by the Prime Minister of India on 20th June, 2020 to address the issues of returnee migrant workers and similarly affected rural population by the Covid-19 pandemic.

The GKRA strategy was to employ a multipronged strategy of providing immediate employment and livelihood opportunities to the distressed and in doing so to saturate the villages with public infrastructure and creation of livelihood assets to boost the income generation activities and enhance long term livelihood opportunities.

A total of 116 districts were identified under GKRA in Six States and these districts have a target of constructing over 50,000 CSCs under SBM-G during the GKRA campaign.

out of 1054; Varanasi 559 out of 760; Rae Bareli 542 out of 989 and Mirzapur 498 out of 809.
